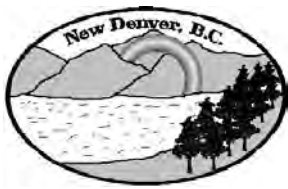

# CITY OF PORT MOODY

To All BC Municipalities,

On January 14, 2020, at a Regular Meeting of Council, Port Moody City Council passed the following resolution:

*Moved, seconded, and CARRIED*

**WHEREAS** the City of Port Moody has recognized and has demonstrated over the past years its commitment to the importance of healthy citizens as the foundation of a healthy, engaged, and economically vibrant community;

**AND WHEREAS** the over 3 million Canadians, including many in our local communities, don't take medicines prescribed by their doctors because they can't afford them;

**AND WHEREAS** Canada is currently the **ONLY** country with a National Medicare Program that does not have a National Pharmacare Program;

**AND WHEREAS** the risk of having no insurance for medicines is high among lower income Canadians which includes the service industry, precarious working, and seasonal workers;

**AND WHEREAS** studies show that adding a National Pharmacare Program to our National Health Care System would lower costs to businesses by over \$8 billion per year, providing Canadian companies competitive advantages in international trade;

**AND WHEREAS** recent research confirms that these gains can be achieved with little or no increase in public investment;

**AND WHEREAS** municipal government expenses for employee benefits would be significantly reduced by a National Pharmacare Program;

**AND WHEREAS** a national prescription drug formulary would support better quality prescribing, including reducing dangerous and inappropriate prescribing to Canadian seniors;

**AND WHEREAS** a National Pharmacare plan is a sound policy, both economically and socially, the City of Port Moody express its support for the creation of a National Pharmacare program as an extension of Canadian Medicare, since health and economic studies now show that such a policy would improve health in municipalities, give local businesses a competitive advantage in the global marketplace, and lower costs for municipal government on taxpayers;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the City of Port Moody call on the Federal Government to work with the provinces and territories to develop and implement a

**Universal Public National Pharmacare program as one of the first orders of business after the 2019 election;**

**AND THAT this letter be forwarded to all BC municipalities asking to write their support as well.**

Attached is the letter that the City of Port Moody sent to the Honourable Patty Hajdu, Minister of Health requesting the Federal Government to start working with the provinces and territories to develop and implement a Universal Public National Pharmacare Program.

We hope that you will join the City of Port Moody and write to the Minister of Health to support the creation of a National Pharmacare Program for all Canadians.

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### SECTION 1: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of our draft Parks Project Priority List. This is the first step towards increasing the visibility of park projects to the Board. The next step will be to work with the Board in order to develop a prioritisation process.

### SECTION 2: BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS

There has been tremendous growth in park projects including the addition of nine new parks or park expansions since 2012. This growth has exceeded internal resource capacity and as a result, project prioritisation has been a critical challenge.

Despite completing successful projects, at the political, staff and community level, there is confusion and frustration around when the RDCK will be able to complete some projects. The projects most likely to be completed, have these project components in place:

- Board approval
- Planning - Management, Design, Development and/or Feasibility etc.
- Public engagement support
- Strong partners and/or stakeholders
- Appropriate funding

The Board has recognised there is a challenge, and in 2019 approved the addition of the Regional Parks Operations Lead position. This has created the opportunity for the Regional Parks Manager to work towards defining goals, plans, responsibilities and expectations for projects on an annual basis.

At the Board level, this is the first presentation of a consolidated list of all parks projects. There are currently 263 Regional Park projects included as Board resolution and/or Staff initiated operational projects on the draft.

The Draft Parks Project List includes 146 projects (excluding operational) categorised in 14 different project types which are primarily capital and planning projects. Each of these project types have their own staff time commitments, outside contract needs and associated costs.

In the absence of a Regional Parks & Trails Strategy, staff has rated the projects Critical, High, Medium and Low. Many of the projects that are rated medium or low are operational based and are yearly operational work or implementation work of some ongoing projects. The work projects are rated by multiple measures including: safety, project scope, how long the work has been identified, active

partnerships, available funding, complexity to complete, ability to contract out and the staff resources required to bring the work project to completion. Although staff has considered these factors in the compiling of the list, this represents the beginning of planning a multi year strategy to complete projects.

The intermediate step is that the Board review work projects and identify projects that are missing and discuss which projects are a priority for the Board. This will provide staff with the opportunity to focus on Board priorities and to better communicate with all stakeholders/commissions staff time commitments and progress on projects.

Although staff understands that priorities may change due to circumstances, both in and out of RDCK control, this report is the first step to align Community, Board and staff priorities so that work progress and planning is transparent.

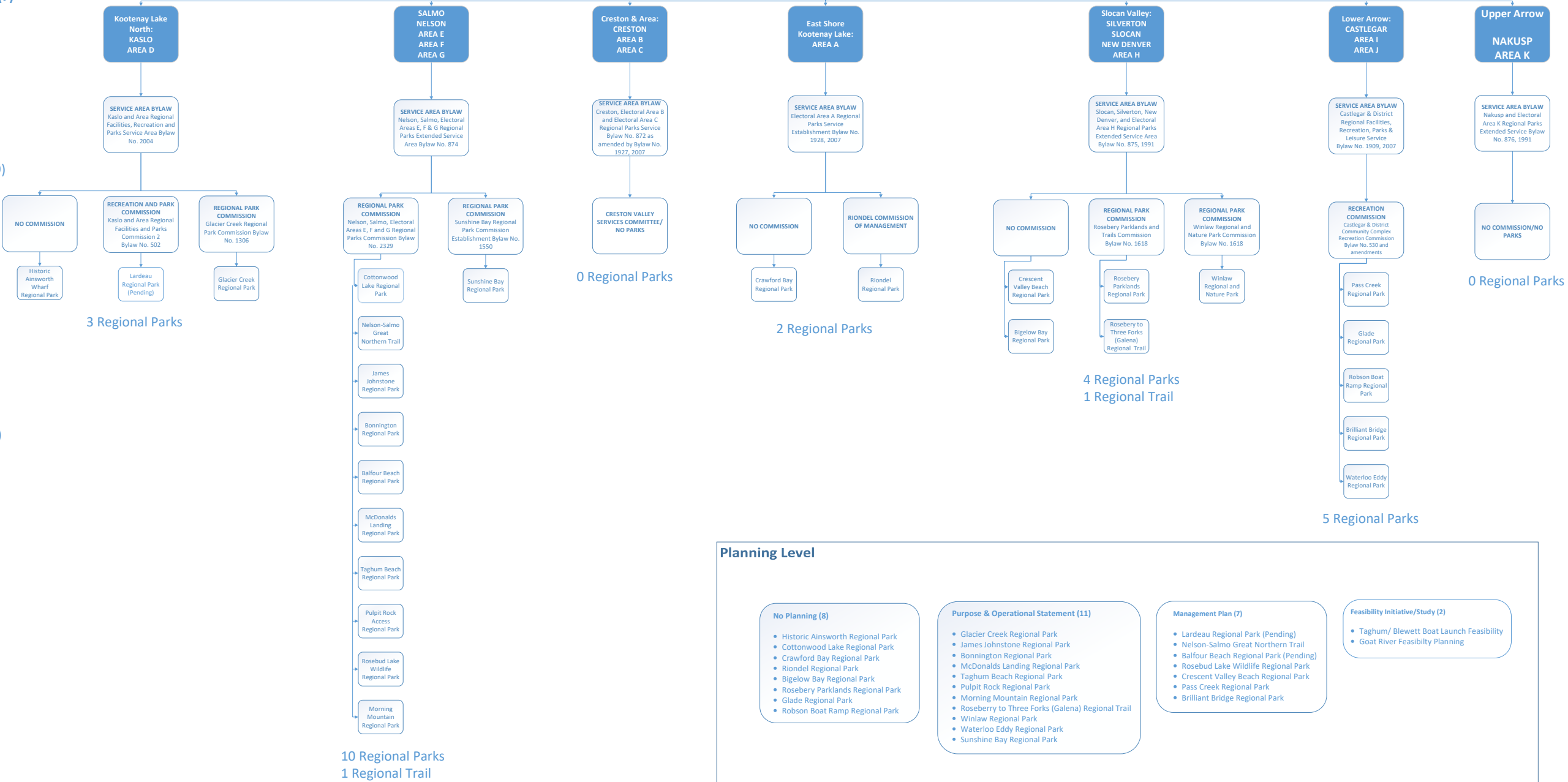
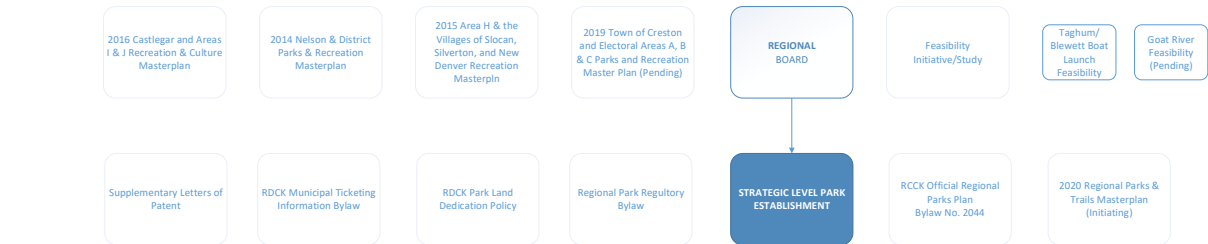

**SUBJECT:** UBCM Poverty Reduction Planning & Action Program Grant Application

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**PURPOSE:** To seek Council approval for a grant application

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Council of the Village of New Denver supports an application to the UBCM Poverty Reduction Planning & Action Program funding stream for Poverty Reduction Plans and Assessments, and further; that the Village of New Denver agrees to provide overall grant management for the project.

**ALTERNATIVES & IMPLICATIONS:**

Data from 2015 shows that 21% of New Denver families were considered low income, compared with a provincial average of 15%, indicating that poverty is a concern for the community. The availability of financial support through the Poverty Reduction Planning & Action Program makes the development of a poverty reduction plan feasible for the Village of New Denver. The proposed work will not proceed if funding is not obtained.

**ANALYSIS:**

- A. Background:** The UBCM Poverty Reduction Planning & Action Program provides grants to local governments to help reduce poverty at the local level and support the provincial poverty reduction strategy. In order to access the Poverty Reduction Action funding stream, a completed Poverty Reduction Plan or assessment or similar documentation is required. The application deadline is February 28, 2020.
- B. Discussion:** The proposed grant application will allow the Village to develop a Poverty Reduction plan for our community. This work will position the Village to access funding for direct actions to reduce poverty locally in future intakes of the program. The Village of New Denver intends to partner with Selkirk College Rural Development Institute (RDI) to complete this work.
