

## Centennial Campground – Phased Reopening

As part of the BC Restart Plan, we are gradually reopening Village amenities with enhanced COVID-19 safety measures.

On May 6, the provincial government released BC's Restart Plan, which outlines a phased approach for gradually re-opening the BC economy. We are currently in Phase 2 and about to enter Phase 3 of the plan.

**In Phase 2, the BC government recommends staying close to home and avoid any travel between communities that is not essential.**

**Phase 3 - If transmission rates remain low or in decline, people can begin travelling throughout B.C.**

The following timelines are planned for the gradual reopening of the Centennial Campground.

### **May 2020 – CLOSED to the public**

#### **June 1-14, 2020 - Limited Availability**

- Campground will be open to self-contained units (RVs or trailers with toilet facilities) **with reservations only**.
- All shared facilities (washroom, showers, wash stations) will remain closed.
- No campground attendant on site.
- Campers will be required to make payment and sani-dump arrangements with the Village Office.
- Sani dump only available during Village Office hours.

#### **June 15 – July 15, 2020 - Campground OPEN – Limited Service**

- Campground will be open to self-contained units (RVs or trailers with toilet facilities) **with reservations only**.
- All shared facilities (washroom, showers, wash stations) will remain closed.
- Campground attendant will be on site.

#### **July 15, 2020 - Campground OPEN**

- It is our intention to resume full service at the campground beginning July 15<sup>th</sup>, however we are monitoring the COVID-19 situation closely and this date is **subject to change without advance notice**.
- Campground attendant will be on site.
