

Nikkei Internment Memorial Centre – Reopening

As part of the BC Restart Plan, we are gradually reopening Village amenities, including the Nikkei Internment Memorial Centre with enhanced COVID-19 safety measures.

On May 6, the provincial government released BC's Restart Plan, which outlines a phased approach for gradually re-opening the BC economy. We are currently in Phase 2 and about to enter Phase 3 of the plan.

In Phase 2, the BC government recommends staying close to home and avoid any travel between communities that is not essential.

Phase 3 - If transmission rates remain low or in decline, people can begin travelling throughout B.C.
