

ALL-WHEELS PARK RULES & EXPECTATIONS

RIDE IN CONTROL AND WITHIN YOUR ABILITY LEVEL AT ALL TIMES. You must be able to stop and avoid other people or objects.

PROTECT YOURSELF. Helmets are mandatory at the All-Wheels Park. Other protective equipment is strongley recommended.

DO NOT RIDE if your ability or judgement is impaired by drugs, alcohol, or fatigue

INSPECT AND MAINTAIN YOUR EQUIPMENT. Have your bike, scooter, skateboard, etc. checked by a qualified mechanic before you ride.

OBEY SIGNS AND WARNINGS. Stay on marked trails. Do not cut switchbacks and keep off of closed areas.

INSPECT TRAILS AND FEATURES. Conditions may change on trails and features.

LOOK OUT FOR OTHERS. When entering a trail, look uphill and yield to other riders.

COOPERATE if you are involved in or witness a collision or accident.

BE VISIBLE. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.

BE WILDSAFE. Do not feed, provoke, or approach wildlife
