The **Foreign Credentials Recognition (FCR) for Internationally Educated Health Professionals (IEHP)** program is dedicated to facilitating the seamless integration of newcomers into the **healthcare sector**. Funded by the government it ensures that international education and work experience align with Canadian standards.

The program objectives include increasing awareness, minimizing FCR process barriers, offering Canadian work experience, and supporting inter-provincial mobility in British Columbia, Alberta, and Ontario.

Canadian Work Experience opportunities for IEHP's

- Provide Canadian Work Experience and Job Placement to eligible Health Care Aides (HCAs)
- Provide a 12-week Wage Subsidy Program for Clinical/Addiction Counsellors and other eligible health professionals across 3 provinces

Inter-Provincial Mobility for IEHP's

- Provide Employment Opportunities and Inter-Provincial Mobility in BC, Alberta and Ontario by reducing systemic and administrative Barriers.
